

Member WiFi at Hertford College

College members can register their devices for WiFi access. This process generates a WiFi code (much like you would use on your home WiFi) for your device. All WiFi codes registered to your account will share a logical network. They will be able to connect to each other (so you'll be able to stream to devices such as Google Chromecast or Apple TV) and the internet, but they will not able to connect to devices registered to other users. Any devices registered to you are your responsibility and Hertford ICT Services reserve the right to block devices if advised by University IT Services that the device is a risk to college or University IT security. Generated WiFi codes are valid for 6 months and devices must be reregistered when the code expires.

Connect to the **HertfordGuest** network. No password is required.

Most devices will automatically detect that there is a registration portal, but if this does not happen open a web browser and go to <u>https://www.hertford.ox.ac.uk</u>. You will be re-directed to the registration page:



Review the Terms & Conditions, check the box to agree to them and click Start.





Click I have an Oxford SSO Account.



Log in with your SSO account.







Disconnect from the **HertfordGuest** network and connect to the **Hertford** network using your new WiFi code.



Hint you can copy and paste the WiFi Code from the registration page into the WiFi settings of your device.

Additional step for Windows and Apple computers

To scan your computer and automatically configure the wireless settings complete the following steps.

Click Continue



Download and run the network wizard.





The wizard will check that that your computer is configured securely and offer instructions for resolving any problems identified. When the scan has confirmed that your device is configured securely it will then prompt to change your system settings, which will automatically connect you to the **Hertford** network.
